

# CSX and Florida

## CSX Operations

- Operates over and maintains approximately 2,800 miles of track\*
- Handles more than 1.4 million carloads of freight annually
- Employed over 6,400 Florida residents with an annual payroll of more than \$375 million in 2007
- Invested more than \$150 million to maintain and upgrade track in 2007
- Products shipped include consumer goods, containerized freight, phosphorus rock, export phosphate, coal, and passenger vehicles

## CSX Facilities

- Major rail yards in Jacksonville (Moncrief), Tampa, Orlando (Taft), and Baldwin
- CSX Intermodal terminals in Jacksonville, Orlando, and Tampa
- TRANSFLO<sup>SM</sup> terminals in Ft. Lauderdale, Jacksonville, Sanford, and Tampa
- Automotive distribution centers in Jacksonville (Blount Island, Talleyrand, and Westside), Orlando, Jupiter (Palm Center), and Tampa
- Corporate headquarters in Jacksonville

## Environmental Advantages of Rail

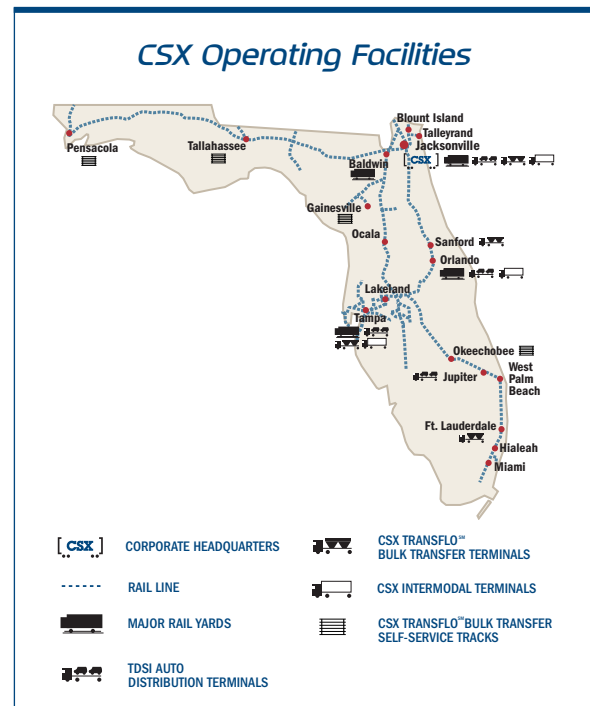
- Railroads are the most environmentally friendly and energy efficient way to move goods on land. A single train can carry the load of more than 280 trucks.
- On average, railroads are three or more times more fuel efficient than the alternative. Trains can move a ton of freight 423 miles on a single gallon of fuel.
- Since 1980, CSX has improved its fuel efficiency by approximately 80 percent, and with constant innovation, freight rail becomes more efficient every day. In the past five years, CSX has invested more than \$1 billion to upgrade its fleet with more fuel efficient locomotives.
- Shifting 10% of long-haul freight from the highway to the railway would reduce annual greenhouse gas emissions by more than 12 million tons.
- The EPA estimates that moving freight by rail emits three times less nitrogen oxide and particulates per ton-mile than highway transportation.

## CSX and the Community

- CSX is dedicated to protecting the safety of the community and environment both through its business practices and its philanthropy. The company focuses on safety and service, environmental stewardship, and on being a positive influence on the communities we serve.
- CSX is a City Year site sponsor for a youth service corps in Miami. CSX sponsored a City Year service day in Jacksonville at Edward Waters College. Through its partnership, CSX brings its focus on safety and excellence to City Year with an emphasis on directly impacting communities across the country.

## Passenger and Commuter Rail Operations

- Tri-Rail commuter trains operate in South Florida daily.
- Amtrak operates approximately 60 trains per day over 34% of CSX's railroad in every state except Tennessee, New Jersey, and Delaware.
